#### Reminders

If you test positive for COVID-19

EVERYONE, regardless of vaccination status STAY HOME FOR 5 DAYS

If you have no symptoms or if your symptoms are improving after 5 days, you may leave your house.

Continue to wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days.

#### Stay Home If You Have A Fever!

If you are exposed to someone with COVID-19

If you have had a booster <u>OR</u> Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months <u>OR</u>

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months.

Wear a mask around others for 10 days Test on day 5, if possible <u>If you develop symptoms, get</u> <u>tested and stay home</u>

If you: Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and have not had booster

<u>OR</u>

Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and have not had a booster <u>OR</u> Are Unvaccinated

Stay Home for 5 days. Then, wear a mask around others for 5 additional days

If you are unable to quarantine, you must wear a mask for 10 days.

Test on day 5, if possible

If you develop symptoms, get tested and stay home
